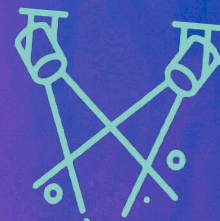
The Arts

There are a wide variety of opportunities for you to meet industry professionals and pursue job shadowing in the field that you are interested in!

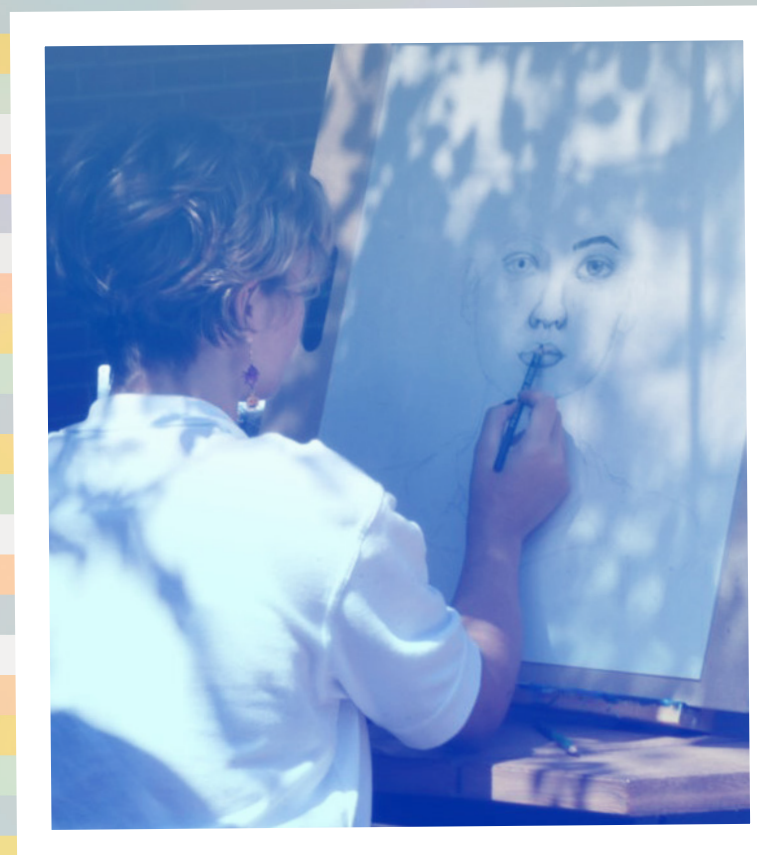
